NEW VIDEO | AMETLLER ORIGEN'S AGRO-INDUSTRIAL HUB IN MONT-ROIG

BioBoost has produced a short video presenting Ametller Origen's strategic project in Mont-roig del Camp: an innovative agro-industrial hub designed as a sustainable, efficient and circular food production model.

With a planned investment of €50 million and start-up foreseen for 2027, the project combines agricultural production through hydroponic greenhouses with research, logistics and advanced biomass valorisation and renewable energy solutions, including anaerobic digestion, pyrolysis and photovoltaic energy.



TAGAMANENT INAUGURATES A PILOT PLANT THAT TURNS WOOL INTO NEW CIRCULAR RESOURCES

On 11 December, the municipality of Tagamanent inaugurated a pilot wool processing plant that is already positioning itself as a reference for circularity in the Montseny area and across Catalonia.

The project gives new value to local wool through renewable energy and specialised technology, producing three final outputs: organic fertiliser, fibres for new materials, and yarns for spinning.

NEW DECREE TO ACCELERATE RENEWABLE ENERGY AND STRENGTHEN ENERGY RESILIENCE IN CATALONIA

The Catalan Government has approved Decree Law 22/2025, a new regulation aimed at accelerating renewable energy deployment, strengthening the resilience of the electricity system and facilitating the creation of energy communities across Catalonia.

The decree introduces administrative simplifications, regulates battery storage systems for the first time, and opens the door to greater urban planning flexibility for self-consumption and distributed generation projects.

At BioBoost, we see this new legal framework as a real opportunity to move towards a more sustainable, collaborative and resilient energy model.

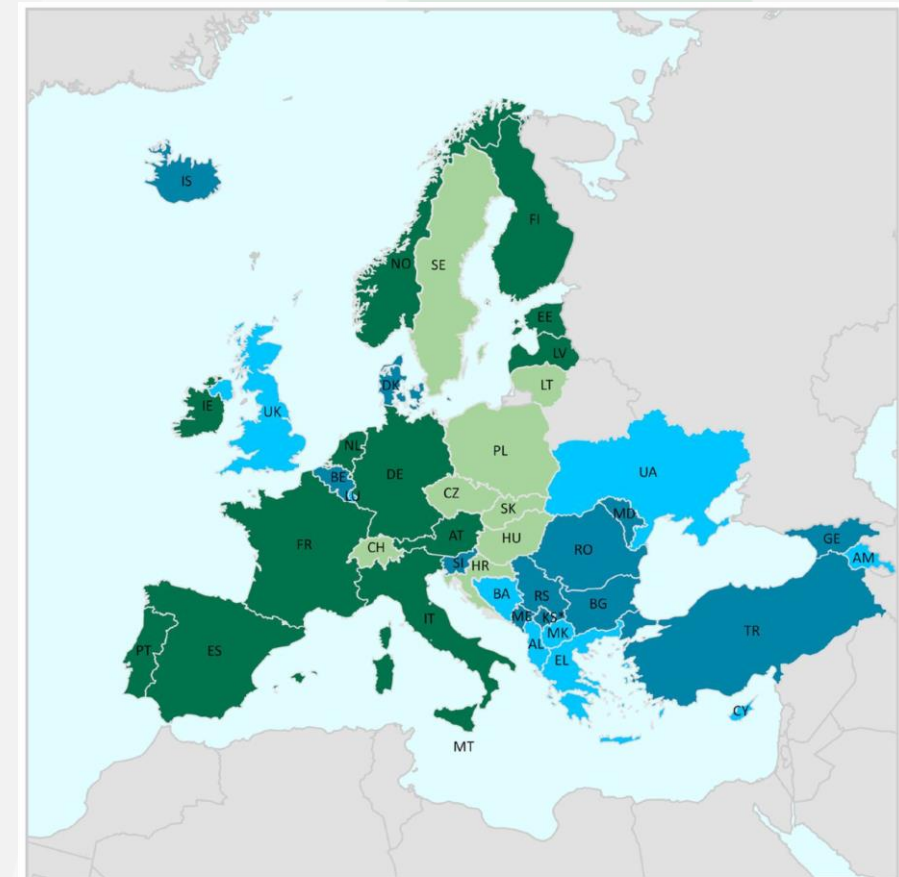
EUROPE STRENGTHENS THE BIOECONOMY WITH A NEW STRATEGY AND UPDATED NATIONAL POLICIES

The European Commission has approved a new Bioeconomy Strategy built around four key priorities: boosting innovation, creating new markets for bio-based materials, ensuring a sustainable biomass supply, and strengthening Europe's global leadership.

At the same time, the Knowledge Centre for Bioeconomy has updated the overview of national strategies, showing clear progress across Europe.

This renewed European framework reinforces Catalonia's commitment to bioeconomy development and highlights the role of accelerators such as Bioboost in turning strategies into real, territory-based projects.
